LOT 1165

An early 19th century ebonized bracket clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking on a bell, the backplate with engraved border and inscribed 'Jn Thwaites London', the painted circular dial with strike/silent indicator above Roman numerals and inscribed 'John Thwaites London', the case with moulded arch pediment and brass carry handle above pierced brass fret panels to front door and sides, on a moulded rectangular plinth base and brass bracket feet, height 48cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

1165. this clock is in good working order and requires very little work to bring up to excellent condition. The main fault is that the bell is no longer secure on its mounting stand due to the security nut being stripped and a new nut will be required. The dial has been repainted at some stage and there is some cracking to the ebony veneers, particularly one of the triple pads. Inlaid back door escutcheon has a piece missing.
