A late 19th/early 20th century French lacquered brass and champlevé enamel carriage clock with eight day movement repeating and striking on a gong, the dial with black Arabic numerals, the case with polychrome enamelled handle and bands, on turned feet, height 15cm.

Condition Report

1197. Lacquer case is worn. Small hairline to edge of dial on left hand side (approx 0.8cm long). Tiny chips to a few corners of bevelled glass panels. Cloisonné decoration in good condition and other than wear to lacquer case, in generally good order. Not running.

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
