A late 19th century French ormolu and white marble four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, above a sunburst mask pendulum, the circular enamel dial with black Arabic numerals and flower festoons, inscribed '... Lyon', the case with bevelled glass panels applied with ormolu ribbon bow and laurel swag, above inset mask and foliate scroll bands, on a plinth base and bracket feet, height 48.8cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £2,500 - £3,500

Condition Report

1177. The case in generally good condition but a bit dusty and dirty so would benefit from a clean. Small chip to top corner of glass back panel, otherwise all other panels in good order. Ormolu is all present but a bit dirty. Marble also in good order. Enamel dial is in good order with minor chips around winding holes. No glass front to hinged dial door. The pendulum does not have a number on it.

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
