### LOT 1510

A Rogers blue printed pearlware Fallow Deer pattern supper set, circa 1820-25, comprising four shaped tureens and covers and a circular footed tureen and cover, each with lion head finial, set into a contemporary oval mahogany tray with upright brass handles, impressed mark to bases of tureens, length of tray 56cm (minor faults to tray).

Estimate: £300 - £500

### Condition Report

1510. Overall in very good condition with no restoration.

Circular central tureen - cover has small chip to inner edge of flange and two very minor nicks to rim edge. Lion finial with one chipped ear. Faint starcrack to side of tureen.

Other tureens - one cover with pinhead sized minute glazed nick to rim edge, one base with small chip to footrim, one base with miniscule graze to glaze on one corner.

Tray - missing small section of veneer to inner edge, some vertical splits to rim and typical light surface wear/scratches. Wooden inserts added to handles on tray exterior to provide extra support, one of which has become a little loose.
