A late 19th century brass cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the black chapter ring with gilt Roman numerals, the architectural case with seated goddess Athena surmount above relief friezes, Corinthian columns and two classical figures, on a stepped plinth base, height 47cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1153. In overall poor condition and appears to have been given an all-over coat of brown paint. The mechanism is not of the type that is normally associated with this style of clock and may have been replaced. The mechanism is in a very dirty condition and will require a full overhaul to return to working order.
