A pair of Derby porcelain figural candlesticks, late 18th century, each modelled as a seated lady or gallant, each wearing colourful costume, leaning against a gilt enriched balustrade with flower encrusted bocage, on a rococo scroll moulded base, heights 27cm and 27.5cm (some restoration).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1458. Both heavily restored and overpainted, including to:

Lady - the sconce, drip pan, both arms and the bocage.

Gallant - the sconce, drip pan, left hand, hat and some edges of scrolls on base. Typical losses to bocage with some light restoration.

Both also have typical manufacturing firing cracks to bases.
