A late 19th century mahogany 'D' end extending dining table with two extra leaves, the moulded top above a frieze with carved scrolling decoration, raised on fluted supports and outswept legs terminating in brass caps and castors, height 75cm, overall extended length 277cm, depth 132cm.

2035. The two leaves are matched-up to the table and do not have the attached frieze panels. There are no brackets for clips or clips present. The top is quite scuffed and marked and there is typical wear to the edges and corners of the base. The table is probably early 20th century and not late 19th century.
