A pair of Meissen porcelain figures, late 19th/early 20th century, modelled after Acier as a boy standing beside a column with a basket of grapes on top, his girl companion feeding grapes to a bird, underglaze blue crossed swords and incised and impressed shape No. 'F.24' to bases, height 12.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1484. Boy - indistinct minor glaze chip to back edge of base. Flat chip to underside edge of jacket which does not really show, and two smaller nicks to one front corner of jacket. Minor chips to two vine leaves in basket. Girl - nibbled chip to front edge of base. Glued repair to wreath around bird which has losses and chips. Bird missing beak. Girl missing right thumb and index finger.
