LOT 4080

A Chinese blue glazed porcelain bottle vase (tianqiuping), mark of Qianlong and probably of the period, the thickly potted globular body rising to a tall cylindrical neck, covered in a dark blue glaze thinning towards the rim, leaving the interior and base glazed white, underglaze blue seal mark to base, height 55.3cm (restoration to neck). Note: a similar cobalt blue bottle vase was included in 'The Wonders of the Potter's Palette' exhibition, Hong Kong Museum of Art, 1984, number 85.

Estimate: £15,000 - £20,000

Condition Report

4080. U-shaped section of the neck approx 18cm long by 7.5cm deep broken away in 3 pieces and with museum style restoration and minor over-painting along the break lines. Starcrack to base with one branch leading through the seal mark to the footrim. Chip to glaze pooling at footrim. Otherwise generally in good condition with some surface scratches and overall pitting to glaze.
