LOT 4087

A set of five Chinese turquoise ground porcelain bowls and eight matching saucers, Qianlong period, each piece decorated with three Imari palette paper resist leaf shaped panels, reserved against a turquoise enamelled ground, iron red painter's marks to bases of some, diameter of bowl 14cm, diameter of saucer 20.5cm (rim chips and hairlines).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

4087. Bowls - two are in generally good condition with only minor rim chips. One with circular haircrack to base and 2cm hairline to rim. One with starcrack to base and 3cm hairline to rim emanating from small chip. Last bowl with 4cm hairline and numerous chips to rim.

Saucers - all 8 with stacking wear to turquoise ground. 2 in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. 1 with 3.5cm hairline and minor chip to rim. 1 with 2cm and 3cm hairline crack and tiny chip to rim. 2 with minor rim chips. 2 with more significant hairline cracks to rims with minor chips and starcracks to bases.
