A collection of Chinese export porcelain, 18th century, including a famille rose bowl and cover, Yongzheng period, painted with mandarin ducks and peonies, height 10cm (restoration), two famille rose teabowls and three saucers, painted with landscapes within bianco-sopra-bianco borders, a small famille rose cylindrical box and cover, and other teabowls and saucers (faults).

Condition Report

4092. Bowl and cover with ducks - rim restoration and yellowed over-painting to interior. Cover in good condition.

2 famille rose teabowls - one in good condition with minor wear to gilding and enamels, the other with small chip to rim. The accompanying 3 saucers - one with minor chips to rim and wear to gilding and enamels, one with hairline crack to rim, one with minor chips and wear overall.

Box and cover - generally in good condition but with faint starcracks to both pieces.

Pair famille verte teabowls - one badly broken, cracked and repaired. Other with 3 hairline cracks to rim and minor chips.

Pair pink scale teabowls - both with hairline cracks and minor rim chips.

2 other famille rose teabowls - one with hairline and minor rim chips, the other with minor rim chips.

2 other teabowls - one with hairline cracks, other in good condition.

Famille rose saucer - numerous rim chips and hairline cracks, wear to enamels.

2 Café-Au-Lait saucers - both with hairline cracks.
