## LOT 4138

A collection of Chinese export porcelain, 18th century, comprising an armorial meat dish, Qianlong period, painted en grisaille with a coat of arms, length 42.2cm, a grisaille decorated punch bowl, diameter 26cm, a blue glazed punch bowl with iron red decoration to interior, diameter 26.3cm, an oval sauce boat, painted with armorials, length 19.5cm, four plates and a soup plate (all with faults).

## Condition Report

4138. Armorial meat dish - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Overall rubbing to gilding and grisaille decoration. Chip to underside rim edge.

Grisaille punch bowl - approx 6cm vertical hairline to rim and restoration and overpainting to body.

Blue punch bowl - chip to rim, extensive scratching and wear to interior, almost all gilt rubbed to exterior.

Sauce boat - missing cover, minor rim chips, some wear to gilding and enamels.

4 plates - Chinese Imari plate 23.5cm diameter with 4.5cm hairline and chip to rim, wear to gilt and enamels. 3 famille rose plates 23.5cm diameter - 2 with chips to rims and 1 of these also with starcrack to base, each with wears to enamels and gilding.

Soup plate - diameter 22.8cm, chips to rim, the centre and rim later overpainted with black leaves.
