Condition Report

4149. White lily - generally fair condition but some damp staining and spotting all over. Slight rippling to paper in corners.

Chrysanthemum - generally fair condition but some damp staining and spotting all over. Slight rippling to paper in corners.

Blossom branch - in similar condition but with less staining. Slight rippling to paper in corners.

Smaller picture - in generally good order with very minor brown spotting and slight crinkling to paper.

All frames in generally good order.
