A pair of Japanese Imari porcelain cylindrical jardinières, early 18th century, with later European ormolu mounts, each cylindrical body moulded in low relief and enamelled with chrysanthemums and demimon to the rim, height 14cm (one rim mount missing).

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

4163. First - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repair, some wear to enamels and gilding, typical surface scratches. Metal mounts are present but a bit worn.

Second - missing metal rim and handle mounts, otherwise the porcelain in generally good condition with typical wear to enamels and gilding and surface scratches. Some wear to mounts on base.
