## LOT 4165

An exceptional Japanese ivory table screen and stand, Meiji period, the rectangular panel finely carved in relief and stained to both sides, one side with a scene of five monkeys playing with fruiting grape vine, the reverse with the Seven Gods of Fortune and a red stained signature seal, within a pierced border of chrysanthemums and peonies, the stand carved and pierced with further flowers, height 38.5cm.

## Condition Report

4165. Generally overall in good condition.

Panel - 7 Gods side, very minor repair to lower right corner chrysanthemum frame, otherwise the pierced border appears to be in excellent condition. The central panel slightly loose to lower left corner. Monkey side, each side of inner frame with vertical splits and small losses to lower corners.

Stand - left hand side upright has been broken and repaired with a new section of brass runner approx 3.5cm long, with a few indistinct minor chips. Otherwise in good order.
