## LOT 4179

A Caughley porcelain tureen cover, late 18th century, decorated in underglaze blue with floral sprays beneath an acanthus fruit knob, length 22cm (small chip), together with a Worcester porcelain butter tub cover, a pair of Staffordshire porcelain sauce tureens and one cover painted with birds between floral moulded detail, four other porcelain covers and an inkwell (faults and repairs).

## Condition Report

4179. Caughley tureen cover - in good condition overall with no cracks or restoration. Approx 1.5cm long narrow chip to inner flange, finial missing one bud and with some minor chips.

Worcester cover - very minor chips to edges of bud finial otherwise in good condition with no cracks or restoration.

Pair tureens - first with very faint starcrack to base and very minor chip to rim, gilt rim rubbed with typical wear to base interior. Second with 2 very minor nibbles to foot. The one cover with 2 small chips to inner flange. Overall enamels good.

Green cover - riveted and soldered repair to finial.

Turquoise cover - some chipping to edge.

Rose finial cover - typical losses and chips to relief detail, tiny nick to rim edge.

Other floral cover - significant losses to relief detail.

Inkwell - lacking liner and cover, overall surface scratches.
