### LOT 4182

A pair of English porcelain oval tureens, covers and liners, probably Coalport, circa 1805, each painted with a border of pink roses and daisies between gilt banding, one liner divided, the other plain, unmarked, length 31cm, together with a set of eleven English porcelain soup plates and twelve dinner plates, decorated with scattered floral sprays within low relief floral moulded borders and blue edged rims (faults).

### Condition Report

4182. Tureen bases - both are in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding on one is quite worn in heavy patches, the gilding on the other has minor typical rubbing in the normal places.

Tureen covers - both are in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is varying degrees of wear to the gilding on both.

Divided liner - manufacturing firing cracks to edges of divider, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Gilding heavily worn and not visible in most areas.

Other liner - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Heavy wear to gilding.

11 soup plates - 5 in good condition, 2 ok but heavily crazed, 3 with haircracks to the rim, 1 ok but crazed with minuscule nick to rim.

12 dinner plates - 5 ok, 1 ok with minute nick to rim, 1 ok with faint hairline to rim, 5 heavily crazed with staining.
