### Condition Report

4183. Generally all in good condition with no restoration and minimal wear/surface scratches to glaze and enamels.

Teapot - tiny nick to underside rim edge of cover and similar nicks to tip of spout.

Sugar - some very minor crazing and indistinct staining

Teacups - 2 with crack to lower handle terminal.

Saucers - one badly cracked.
