### LOT 4191

A large Dutch Delft Cashmere palette ribbed vase and cover, late 18th century, of octagonal shape, painted in chinoiserie style with an exotic bird perched on pierced rockwork by a fence with chrysanthemum and prunus, beneath other birds in flight, flanking an urn of flowers between floral and scroll filled lambrequin borders, the domed cover with spherical knob, unmarked but with paper 'loan' label to base, height 50cm (faults), together with a Delft blue painted ribbed gourd shaped vase, height 38cm (minor faults).

### Condition Report

4191. Cashmere palette - approx 21cm long vertical but curved crack running from rim and terminating almost halfway down the body of the vase, another similar vertical crack to rim approx 9cm long, with other indistinct and very minor glaze hairlines to rim. Otherwise in good order with typical frits/chipping to footrim. Cover in good condition with a few minor frits/chips.

Gourd shaped vase - approx 1cm long by 0.5cm wide chip to exterior edge of footrim, a similar sized chip to neck rim exterior and another smaller alongside, otherwise in good condition.
