A Dutch or German pale green tinted Daumenglas and cover, late 17th/early 18th century, of barrel shape with eight concave thumbholes to the middle section between trailed banding, with an applied ring foot, height 24cm (main body cracked, finial glued). Note: the concave holes were to aid a firm grip, as these drinking vessels became quite heavy once filled.

Condition Report

4208. Old glued repair to finial of cover, no missing pieces. Approx 11cm long by 2cm deep section of footrim badly cracked or possibly broken away and re-glued with minor losses along it and a vertical haircrack reaching approx 7cm up into the main body.
