A white gold and diamond ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond between baguette diamond single stone shoulders, detailed '18ct', ring size approx M.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

515. The principal diamond slightly draws colour. There is a considerable cluster of mostly gletz inclusions by one claw. There is a black pique inclusion near to the edge of the table facet of the diamond. There is a slight nick to the edge of the principal diamond by one shoulder. The shoulder diamonds are well matched for colour with the centre stone however, one of these shoulder diamonds has been dislodged in its setting. The principal diamond carat weighs approx 0.80ct. Weight 4.4g. The mount is in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear.
