A gold, cultured pearl and diamond circular brooch, the centre with a clenched fist holding a rose cut diamond set crown within a surround of graduated cultured pearls, diameter 3.5cm, with a case.

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

610. The silver setting of the central crest motif is heavily tarnished and makes the diamonds look rather grey. Their appearance may be enhanced as a result of careful professional cleaning. There is some variation of colour to the surrounding cultured pearls. One cultured pearl is lacking most of its surface nacre and shows the bead beneath. Suggested age circa 1900. The case is associated and rather worn. Weight 11.8g.

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
