## LOT 659

A gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with a row of cushion shaped diamonds graduating in size to the centre stone, detailed '18ct', ring size approx L.

Estimate: £1,800 - £2,200

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## Condition Report

659. The old cut diamonds are well matched for colour. There is a sizable chip to one diamond next to the principal diamond. The principal diamond has an internal gletz inclusion to the side by a claw. The other diamonds have one or two internal inclusions. The diamond mount is of a later date than the design would suggest. It is likely that the five principal diamonds were together in a previous ring setting and have subsequently be re-mounted in a setting of an Edwardian design. The principal diamond carat weight is approx 0.75ct. The next two larger diamonds weigh approx 0.60ct each and the two smallest diamonds weight approx 0.40ct each. Weight 6.8g.

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
