Condition Report

1239. Bronze duck - left foot with two broken and missing toes, right foot with broken and missing toe and a repaired toe. Otherwise the duck is in generally good order with only tip of one wing broken off.

Japanese fish - not particularly good quality and some surface wear.

Hardwood stand - missing sections of pierced apron to both tiers, structurally the stand is in good order with both platforms and legs in good condition.

Kutani vase - small chip to rim, otherwise good condition. Minor wear to gilt.
