A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain oil lamps, mid to late 19th century, each of high shouldered tapering form, painted with opposing bird panels against a blue ground filled with birds amidst fruit and flowers, raised on ormolu bases beneath gilt metal mounts and oil lamp fittings, height of vases 37cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1212. Both in good condition, no apparent damage to the porcelain and only very minor typical wear to enamels. Brass work is slightly worn, but nothing significant. Ormolu bases in good order with only minor wear.
