Three Chinese Canton export ivory boxes with hinged lids, late 19th century, two of rectangular form, the other square, each top and sides carved and pierced with figures, flowers or dragons, lengths 12.7cm, 10.1cm and 8.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1243. Larger box - overall good condition, one pierced section of apron missing.

Square box - overall fairly good condition, few minor natural shrinkage cracks to edges of the top. One section of pierced apron missing, another detached but present.

Smaller rectangular box - overall generally good condition, one piece of pierced apron is detached but present, pierced work in good order.
