A Japanese lacquered and parquetry inlaid table-top cabinet, Meiji period, with engraved copper mounts and handles, the top, back and side panels decorated with gilt and silvered feathers, fitted with an arrangement of sliding doors, drawers and cupboard, the fronts finely lacquered with precious objects, cranes and an eagle amidst pine, height 44.5cm, width 46.5, depth 31.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1043. Overall generally good condition but with some wear and minor chips. One door has a missing small handle/latch. The only really significant damage is a vertical split to the back panel, couple of minor splits to one side panel and some hairlines to edges of lacquer panel on top. Otherwise there is generally fading to wood and minor surface wear. All metal mounts are present, some securing pins missing. Almost all condition issues are visible on our website images using our close-up feature.
