A George III Scottish silver three-piece tea set of half-reeded circular form with foliate capped handles and gadrooned rims, raised on claw and ball feet, comprising teapot, two-handled sugar bowl and milk jug, Edinburgh 1815 by John McDonald, height of teapot 17cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

312. All three pieces with clear readable marks to bases. Some slightly rubbed. All marks match. Weight 1390g.

Teapot - generally good condition but a little worn with a few minor dents. Handle is a little wobbly as one small pin is missing. No repairs.

Milk jug - feet are pushed into body a bit which is visible to interior. Small repair to base of handle.

Sugar bowl - solder repair to cartouche on side which still has a small hole.
