A George III silver six egg cruet stand of circular form, surmounted with a central circular salt with overhead handle, on tapering reeded legs and foliate feet, fitted with six egg cups, Birmingham 1807 by Matthew Boulton, height 17cm, together with a set of six silver egg spoons, London 1808 by William Eley, William Fearn & William Chawner.

Condition Report

335. Weight 791g.

The frame - six cups all have matching hallmarks. The salt is integral so does not detach from the frame and is therefore not marked. All interiors are gilt. Some wear to gilt interiors and minor misshaping to rims but nothing of any real significance. Overall in good condition with typical light wear and would benefit from a clean.

Spoons in generally good order.
