Condition Report

1133. The mandala has been repaired and re-glued at the back where it meets the stand. Some paint flaking to back of mandala and stand. Some typical wear to paintwork and gilt. One finial missing to the gallery of pedestal. Some separation to joints of stand and some re-gluing. Minor flaking and losses.
