A late 17th/early 18th century silk needlework panel depicting various figures within an unusual landscape scene with building, bridge and trees, populated by birds, squirrel, frog, deer and a rabbit, worked in a variety of stitches on an ivory silk ground, 48cm x 53cm, within a later oak frame.

Condition Report

2801. The silk background is substantially shot in most areas, however the stitching and embroidery is generally ok, with overall fading and muting of colours, as well as a general overall browning.

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
