A pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain vases, Kangxi period, each baluster body painted with a design of scrolling lotus and tendrils, height 23cm (cut down and one with star crack to base).

Condition Report

1063. Both vases have been cut down as they would originally have had flared necks. Otherwise they are in generally good condition. One has a starcrack hairline to base and slightly misfired glaze which has left the paintwork slightly 'bumpy' in places. Other vase in good order.
