A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, late 19th century, of baluster form, painted with a design of lotus and leafy tendrils between ruyi head, stiff leaf and lappet borders, unmarked, height 39.4cm (drilled hole and small hairline to base).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1181. Drilled hole to base where it had been mounted as a table lamp base. 3.5cm hairline crack running out from the drill hole. Otherwise vase is in good condition with no other chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface wear/scratches to glaze but nothing significant. Nicely painted decoration.
