A Chinese gilt decorated iron red porcelain vase, late Qing dynasty, the shouldered body and flared neck gilt with a design of lotus and scrolling tendrils, height 18.5cm, together with a Chinese blue and white tea caddy and cover, painted with prunus, height 13.5cm, and a Chinese famille rose export porcelain tea bowl (hairline crack).
