A Chinese famille rose export porcelain reticulated circular saucer dish, early Qianlong period, finely painted with a pair of exotic birds perched amidst fruiting and blossoming branches emanating from pierced blue rockwork with pink peonies, the reticulated border with yellow and brown enamelled decoration with a turquoise cell diaper rim, diameter 25.3cm.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

1015. On very close inspection there is a very faint hairline crack at 7 o'clock running from the rim to the first bit of piercing and no further. This hairline is only visible under magnification. Small chip to edge of footrim. Otherwise dish is in good condition with no restoration. Enamels and gilt are good and vibrant.
