## LOT 2003

A pair of late 19th century ebonized and gilt metal mounted display cabinets, each domed top above a single glazed door, the stands with blind fretwork friezes and raised on square tapering legs, height 181cm, width 83cm, depth 46cm.

## Condition Report

2003. Overall condition of both cabinets is fair but with general wear and tear through use, overall surface scuffs and marks.

One cabinet has some loose metal mounts with some of the curved top mounts lifting. The door to this cabinet is a bit stiff to open and there is one fretwork corner bracket missing to rear side. One of the curved glass panels at the top has been replaced with perspex.

The other cabinet has also had a replaced glass panel on the top. It is missing a gilt metal border mount to side and also two of the fretwork corner brackets. General overall surface scuffs and marks.

Both cabinet interiors have been re-lined in a beige baize fabric but otherwise haven't had any other obvious alterations.
