A Chinese Canton export ivory brisé fan, mid-19th century, the sticks and guards carved and pierced with figures, flowers and pavilions, length 19cm (one guard broken), a Canton enamel wine cup, Qianlong period, painted with two figures and buffalo in landscape, two carved soapstone seals, and a group of six jade and hardstone carvings.

Condition Report

1076. Fan - one guard is warped and has broken and is being held together by tape. It is also unstrung, but otherwise ok.

All carvings in good condition.

Enamel cup - hairline cracks and chips/losses to exterior enamel.
