A Victorian gold and carbuncle garnet bracelet of mesh link form, spaced with six carbuncle garnets, on a snap clasp, length 17.5cm (the seventh carbuncle garnet lacking), cased.

Condition Report

213. One stone missing, other stones have typical light surface wear/scratches visible under magnification. Each stone approx 0.8cm diameter and 0.4cm deep. Clasp in good order. Gold is slightly discoloured and would benefit from a clean. Some mesh links slightly misshapen, but generally good. Case has scuffs to exterior and minor staining to interior, but generally in good order with good hinge. Base is detailed in gilt 'Lee & Son Belfast'. Weight 17.9g. This piece is unmarked but tests as approx 15ct.
