A gold and diamond ring in a pierced marquise shape, set with rose cut diamonds between pierced sides, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

222. The rose diamonds are of varying proportions, most have a few internal inclusions. The central rose diamond has a chip to the edge and numerous internal inclusions. The setting of the principal central diamond is damaged at one end and otherwise shows signs of work. The black enamel to the border of the diamonds has been considerably restored. There is lead solder visible to the underside of the head of the ring supporting the connecting pins from the top. The ring is generally reconstructed. The shank is of indeterminate age. Weight 4.7g.

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
