A pair of Scottish gold mounted vari-coloured agate cufflinks, each front and back in a domed hexagonal design, length of each front and back 1.6cm.

Condition Report

295. The suggested age of the cufflinks is the 2nd half of the 19th century. On one side of one cufflink, a piece of jasper has been re-glued into position with considerable over spilling of glue onto the agates on either side. The other side of this cufflink is in good condition. The other cufflink is in generally better condition. Otherwise there are a few surface marks to the edges of the agates. Weight 8.4g.

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
