### LOT 330

A gold, silver and diamond cluster ring, mounted with the principal cushion shaped diamond within a surround of smaller cushion shaped diamonds between split shoulders, detailed '18ct', ring size approx P, with a box.

Estimate: £1,700 - £2,000

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### Condition Report

330. The principal old European cut diamond slightly draws colour and has one or two gletz inclusions to the centre of the stone. The central diamond weight approx 0.90ct. The surrounding diamonds have slight variation of cut but are generally well matched and slightly draw colour. The surrounding diamonds weigh approx 0.05ct per stone. Colour approx I-J; Clarity approx SI1-SI2. The ring is of an earlier style than it actually is. Weight 4.1g. Head of ring approx 1.3cm diameter.

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
