Condition Report

953. There are numerous overall areas of damage, loss and repair to the gesso work. The eagle is in generally good order but the delicate gesso work, the leaf sprays and the central oval wreath, all have considerable damage and repair. The brass drip pans and the wall plate have been drilled for electrical use.
