Condition Report

28. Overall good condition.

Hand mirror - silver and enamel in good condition with only typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks. The glass mirror has slipped slightly in its mounting.

Two clothes brushes - good condition with only typical minor surface scratches to enamel and silver. Good hallmarks.

Two hairbrushes - both in good condition with only typical minor surface scratches to enamel and silver, one has a tiny nick to edge of silver. Good clear hallmarks.
