An Elizabeth II silver rectangular pillbox, decorated in relief with foliate scrolls, Birmingham 1966 by Joseph Gloster Ltd, length 5.1cm, together with a silver and enamelled circular pillbox, decorated with a fox's head, Edinburgh 1977, a silver twin-compartment sovereign case and a gilt metal sovereign case.

### Condition Report

39. Sovereign and half sovereign case - spring hinge is good but the interior of the hinge lid has had a strap support applied. Exterior with some typical wear to engraving. Both coin holder springs in good order.

Hallmark to inner lid obscured by the applied strap.

Rectangular box - good condition, good clear marks. Engraved initials to top.

Silver and enamel pill box - good condition, typical wear and scratches to silver sides.

Gilt metal sovereign case - small dents to front and back and wear to case. Hinge is also damaged.

Rectangular pill box & two-compartment sovereign vase only - weight 86.2g.
