A large 19th century mahogany inverted breakfront library bookcase, the moulded pediment above astragal glazed doors and panelled cupboards, on a plinth base, height 266cm, width 350cm, depth 36cm.

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

2015. The bookcase appears to have been made up from at least two separate pieces of furniture. The two end cupboards appear the same, but the central pair of cupboards are slightly different. The main issue is that the glazed section is an inverted breakfront, while the base is a normal breakfront, leaving areas of unveneered wood and unfinished sections. The ends of the bookcase are unfinished and certain sections of the bookcase do not join properly. It is probably destined to be re-used and made into something else. Height 266cm, width 350cm, depth 36cm.
