A Rolex Oyster Perpetual steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed silvered dial with baton shaped numerals and centre seconds, the case with milled screw back and detailed between the lugs '29052' and 'Brevet 6352', the winding button with a Rolex crown, case diameter 3.5cm.

Condition Report

1023. It is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Glass dial very badly scratched. All lettering is good with no losses, it just appears that way in the images as glass is so badly scratched.

Case with surface scratches and wear but no significant damage, tiny dent to case back. Case diameter 3.5cm and case length 4.2cm

Dial appears to be original. The dial has not turned green around the edges, but there is some discolouring. Dial does not appear to be scratched but it has brown spotted particularly around the edges.

The crown does not screw in properly. No significant damage to lug holes.

The winder is original but does not screw in tightly to case. Winder has Rolex logo. The watch winds smoothly as a manual movement.

The back also looks original.

All lug pin holes look good.

No logo to buckle and no box.

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
