LOT 1191

An 18th century stained pine longcase clock with thirty hour movement striking on a bell, the square brass dial with single hand, matt centre and date aperture framed by a chapter ring with Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Tho Irvine Andover', all cornered by cast and pierced scroll spandrels, the case with rectangular trunk door and glazed lenticle on a plain base, height 195cm, with pendulum and weight (faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The clock mechanism and case in a very distressed state. Much work will be required to bring it back to acceptable and working condition. The mechanism and case are probably original to each other. (ie) there is no blocking up to the seat board and the lenticle and cut out sides are in the correct place for the pendulum. Much work is required on the case which is in a very distressed state. Original weight and pendulum.
