1167. Clock itself is in generally good condition. It winds and adjusts smoothly and is running and appears to keep good time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Case is in good order, but there is some clouding/scratches on the glass front panel around the Jaeger-LeCoultre signature, '8' and 'Swiss' inscriptions.

Box is scuffed and worn, but otherwise ok.
