A pair of 18ct gold, treated ruby and diamond cluster earrings, each claw set with an oval cut treated ruby within a surround of circular and tapered baguette cut diamonds, with post and butterfly fittings, detailed '750', total ruby weight approx 3.19ct, total diamond weight approx 1.00ct, with a case.

Estimate: £1,500 - £1,800

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## Condition Report

535. The earrings are in generally good condition. Cut: oval faceted cut rubies and baguette and modern round brilliant cut diamonds. The florescence of the stones is faint on average. Colour: the rubies are deep red, the diamonds are bright, white and sparkling. Clarity: the ruby is clear to the unaided eye, the diamonds approx VS2-SI1. Weight 5.7g.

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
