### LOT 610

A late Victorian gold, diamond and almandine garnet oval hinged bangle, the front mounted with a row of seven graduated cushion shaped almandine garnets alternating with pairs of cushion shaped diamonds, on a snap clasp, detailed '3104', inside width 5.5cm, total garnet weight approx 7.00ct, total diamond weight approx 1.5ct, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

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### Condition Report

610. The hinge of the bangle is slightly wobbly. The diamonds are attractive fairly white stones with only one or two small internal inclusions. The garnets are of medium colour saturation. The overall condition is good. Cut: old European cut. The florescence of the stones is faint. Colour: deep purple/red almandine garnets, the diamonds approx G-H. Clarity: garnets are clear to the unaided eye, diamonds approx SI1-SI2. Weight 14.5g.

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
